"Introducing a New National Model Code for Green Building"

The District of Columbia's Green Building Act requires the Mayor to submit new building codes to the City Council by January 1, 2010 "that shall incorporate as many green building practices as practicable..." Join us for an informative presentation regarding two model building codes DC is tracking:

- **ASHRAE/USGBC/IESNA/BSR Standard 189.1P** -- in its final stage -- is a national model code that will provide standards for high-performance green building -- applicable to all buildings with the exception of low-rise residential (under four stories). The goal of the new standard is to establish mandatory criteria in all topic areas, provide simple compliance options, and complement green building rating programs.
- **Core Performance Energy Code (Core)**, which was recently adopted by Massachusetts as a stretch code designed to be approximately 20% more energy efficient than the 2009 IECC.

This session is particularly oriented to the developer, the architect, the engineer, and the general contractor working in all jurisdictions throughout the DC area. Do not miss this informative presentation!
